- when I receive set up intro
- show
- point in direction 90
- switch costume to charlie1
- go to x: 110 y: -15
- wait 4 secs
- say Do you think I'm going to fall for that again? for 4 secs
- wait 4 secs
- think Hmm... for 2 secs
- say Well, okay, if you promise I guess you have to do it. for 4 secs

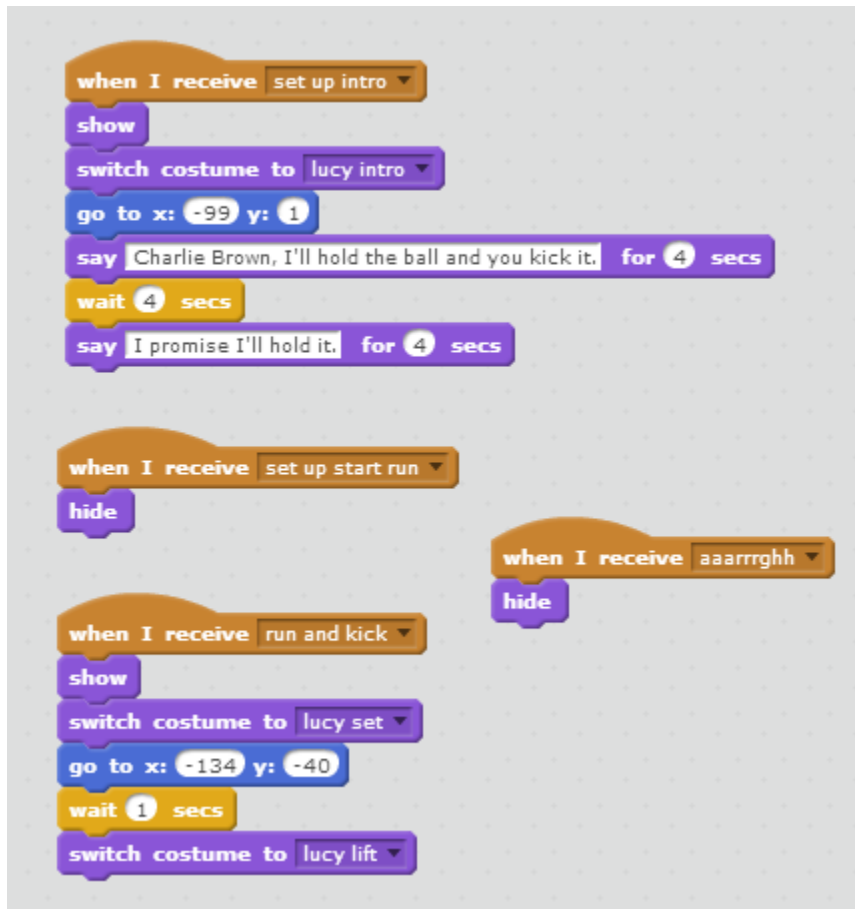
Running Sequence:

- when I receive set up start run
- switch costume to charlie1
- go to x: 173 y: -34
- think Well, here goes nothing... for 2 secs
- repeat 20
 - switch costume to run1
 - change x by -12
 - wait 0.01 secs
 - switch costume to run2
 - change x by -12
 - wait 0.01 secs

Partial script on the right side of the image:

- when I receive set up start run
- go to x: 173 y: -34
- repeat 20
 - switch costume to run1
 - change x by -12
 - wait 0.01 secs
 - switch costume to run2
 - change x by -12
 - wait 0.01 secs

Lucy script



Challenges and ideas

1. Finish the movie by making the Landing Scene and the Final Scene.
2. In the Landing Scene, you can have the dust “settle” by fading out as it gets larger.
3. For the Final Scene, have Lucy appear and say something snarky.
4. You can make the Aaargghhh scene longer by having Charlie Brown do several spins in the air.
5. Big challenge: Can you make a version where Charlie Brown actually kicks the football?
